In this February month our medical team went for a medical camp to a village called Gauran, which is around 50 kms far from Udaipur. We went with one general physician, an ophthalmologist, nurses and volunteers. More than 70 people from Bhil community were checked and given medicines. We found major diseases like Tuberculosis, Upper Respiratory Infections (URIs), Skin Infection and eye problems. Claire was part of the team, we appreciate for all her participations with us in medical camp.



This medical team also went to another place known as Vedla in Udaipur locality, especially among the *Kalbelia* tribe. These people are snake charmers by profession. A small group of children was gathered in one school premises. Some lessons on cleanliness were given to them. The children also practically learned how to wash their hands with soap. In January month we had a medical camp among these people and nearly 130 people were treated and given medicines.
